

**NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
SUMMARY OF FORMAL ACTIONS TAKEN AT
MONDAY, June 13, 2016, REGULAR MEETING**

ACTIONS TAKEN:

Closed Session. The Board entered closed session at 5:44 p.m. pursuant to G.S. 143-318.11 (a)(1) and (a)(6) to discuss personnel matters. Ms. Keedra Whitaker was not present for the vote. Ms. Marjorie Edwards left the meeting at 7:10 p.m. following the end of closed session.

Approval of the Meeting Agenda. The meeting agenda was approved as presented. The Board approved to amend the agenda to add the following agenda items: #13.07 Synovia Contract; #13.08 Child Nutrition Bids; #13.09 Roofing Bids – Conway Middle School and Gaston Elementary School; #13.10 AIG Plan 2016-2019; Personnel becomes #13.11; and move agenda item #15.01 Superintendent’s Information to become agenda item #9.01. The Board approved the agenda to include the addendum items.

Good News Award

William Baxter Martin, a graduate of Northampton County High School, was recognized for receiving the **George & Frances London Educational Foundation Scholarship** in the amount of \$7,500 for the academic year towards attending a college or university of his choice and he is eligible to receive \$3,750 each semester to be applied against his tuition and fees.

Mr. Anthony Arrington, a bus driver at Central Elementary School, was recognized by the Northampton County Schools Transportation Department and the Board of Education and was presented a **School Bus Safety Award** for adhering to the Standard Hand Signal Procedure to ensure the safety of a student on May 10, 2016 during the morning bus transport to school. As of January 1, 2016, all North Carolina public school bus drivers are required to use hand signals to help students safely cross the road to board the bus.

The **Northampton County Board of Education Members** were recognized for their achievement levels obtained for the **2014-2015 North Carolina School Boards Association Academy of School Boardsmanship**. The following Board Members were recognized at the NCSBA 46th Annual

Conference on November 16-18, 2016 in Greensboro, NC: **Ms. Marjorie Edwards** – Diploma of Honor; **Ms. Rhonda Taylor** – Award of Excellence; **Mr. Kelvin Edwards** – Certificate of Advanced Achievement; **Mr. Phil Matthews** – Certificate of Achievement; **Mr. Clinton Williams** – Certificate of Achievement; and **Ms. Lucy Edwards** – Certificate of Merit.

Chair Rhonda Taylor announced to the audience that this is Mr. Phil Matthews' last Board Meeting as a member of the Northampton County Board of Education. She stated that Mr. Matthews was a long time employee with Northampton County Schools and even after he was elected to the Board he still assisted staff members at the Central Office with his expertise. Mr. Matthews, "We appreciate you for working tirelessly with the Board and the many hours we sat in meetings. I know that Mary is going to be happy that you are going home to be with her to spend more time at the beach. We do appreciate everything you have done. Words cannot describe the knowledge that you have and that you have shared with us over the years."

Chair Taylor stated that Mr. Matthews' plaque reads as follows: *In appreciation of your outstanding contributions and dedication to the children of Northampton County Schools as a member of the Northampton County Board of Education from July 2, 2012 to June 30, 2016, given this 13th day of June 2016 by the Northampton County Board of Education.* She asked the Board to stand as she presented the acrylic plaque and a gift card to Mr. Matthews on behalf of the Northampton County Board of Education. Chair Taylor stated, "Mr. Matthews, we appreciate you and we will miss you."

She also informed the audience that Ms. Marjorie Edwards will receive the same acrylic plaque and gift card and we will make sure she receives them. Ms. Edwards was unable to be here for the Open Session of the Board Meeting tonight and this was her last Board Meeting as a member of the Northampton County Board of Education.

Break. The Board took a five-minute break at 8:00 p.m. The Board reconvened the meeting at 8:05 p.m.

Approval of Consent Agenda. The Board approved the minutes under the consent agenda. Budget Amendments. The Board approved that additional budget amendments may be approved by the Superintendent for FY 17 as required to move any funds into the appropriate purpose code based on revision adjustments, receipt of additional funds, or as part of the cleanup process. A report of these adjustments must be made to the Board of Education at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

FY 17 Continuing Resolution Authorization. The Board approved that the Interim Budget is the same as the 2016-2017 school budget until a new budget is adopted. Prudent spending will not exceed one-fourth the amount in each fund code without prior consultation with the Superintendent.

Application for Career and Technical Education (CTE) State/Federal Funding 2016-2017. The Board approved the Application for Career and Technical Education (CTE) State/Federal Funding for fiscal year 2016-2017.

James H. Jones Scholarship Committee and Recommendations. The James H. Jones Scholarship was established to honor the memory of the late James H. Jones, a former Chairman of the Northampton County Board of Education. The Board approved the following changes and edits to the James H. Jones Scholarship as recommended by the James H. Jones Scholarship Committee and recorded in the bylaws and criteria. The James H. Jones Scholarship Committee shall consist of one member of the Board of Education, the Superintendent, one James H. Jones family representative or designee, and other members representative of the following stakeholder groups: central office administrator, principal, teacher, board member, community, and/or business. Ms. Lucy Edwards stated that the Scholarship Committee is proud to announce that William Cumbo, a Northampton County High School graduate, is the recipient of the 2015-2016 James H. Jones Scholarship.

Modified Administration Summer Work Schedule. The Board approved a Modified Administration Summer Work Schedule for all twelve months employees of Northampton County Schools, beginning Monday, June 20, 2016 through Friday, August 5, 2016. Employees would follow a 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. summer schedule, which would allow for a 4-day workweek (10 hours per day and 25 minutes for lunch) and all schools and Central Services would be closed on Fridays.

THE WAY FORWARD PLAN. Dr. Smith-Woofter stated that she would like to update the public regarding The Way Forward Plan in that we had a scheduled joint meeting that we were supposed to have between the Board and the County Commissioners that was supposed to take place sometimes this week between Tuesday and Thursday and as the date drew closer, we could not coordinate time that works for the majority of our Board and the County Commissioners to meet. Instead, during our Finance and Facilities Committee Meeting today, County Manager Kimberly Turner came to submit the proposed budget that will be adopted on June 20, 2016 during the Commissioners' regularly scheduled evening meeting. All of the county departments that have submitted budget requests have a proposed balanced budget that will officially receive approval. The County Manager addressed the Finance and Facilities Committee today, in which the majority of the Board Members were present, to entertain questions and to outline the Commissioners' process for developing their budget. We also discussed that we would work towards, in the near future, of having a retreat between the two Boards so that we can continue strengthening our partnership and working relationship. Also, we have not had a response to the written request from the Board, but Ms. Turner did recommend that we resubmit a letter of reconsideration to the County Commissioners.

Reconsideration of the Board Per Diem Letter. The Board approved to add to the agenda to resubmit a Reconsideration of the Board Per Diem Letter under The Way Forward Plan to become item #13.061 presented to the Commissioners at their next planning meeting.

Synovia Contract. The Board approved to move forward with implementing a contract with Synovia Solutions for the 2016-2017 school year to provide payroll processing, core track and trace, comparative analysis, time and attendance, and Here Comes the Bus on an annually-deferred payment plan.

Chair Taylor announced at 8:45 p.m. that she has to leave the meeting and that she would like to recommend that Ms. Lucy Edwards reside as Chair. The Board approved to appoint Ms. Lucy Edwards as Chair in the absence of Ms. Rhonda Taylor.

Child Nutrition Bids. Quotes for food supplies and services for the Northampton County Schools' School Nutrition Program through June 30, 2016 were previously approved by the Board. The Board approved the rollover bid prices for the 2016-2017 school year for Franklin Baking Company, Maola Milk & Ice Cream Company, and authorized the renewal bid prices from Sysco Lot 1 & 3 for the 2016-2017 school year. This procedure is authorized in the Child Nutrition Procurement Plan and NC Child Nutrition Purchasing Alliance.

Roofing Bids. The Board approved a contract with Triangle Roofing to install a new roof on Gaston Elementary School Gym in the amount of \$116,280.00 and also approved a contract with Wayne Roofing to install a roof at Conway Middle School in the amount of \$25,275.00.

AIG Plan 2016-2019. The Board approved the Northampton County Schools Local Academically or Intellectually Gifted (AIG) Plan for 2016-2019, a three-year cycle plan.

Calendar Teacher Start Date Adjustment. The Board approved to move the Calendar Teacher Start Date Adjustment to an action item.

The Board approved to adjust the calendar teacher start date, delete August 17, 2016 as an optional workday, and make the official start date for teachers to become August 18, 2016 designated as an optional workday.

Dr. Smith-Woofter announced that District Attorney Valerie Asbell would be our Convocation Speaker on Wednesday, August 24th at 1:00 p.m. Our Early College will already be in session on August 10; therefore, August 24th will be an early release day for them.

Reorganization of Schools for 2016-2017. Appointed Chair L. Edwards stated to the audience that in regards to Northampton County Schools' Reorganization of Schools for the 2016-2017 school year, the Board wishes to inform you of the following changes:

- 1) Our current high school has been relocated to the present Gaston Middle School site for next year.
- 2) In regards to Willis Hare Elementary, we have a priority there for safety and the Board has decided that we will construct a breezeway between the two buildings where no one can enter from the parking lot.
- 3) Gaston Middle School and Gaston Elementary School will be sharing school sites on the campus of Gaston Elementary for grades 2-8.
- 4) Gaston Elementary/Squire Site will house grades Pre-K-1, along with our Early College and Alternative Learning Program.
- 5) We also wish to inform you about what the Northampton County Commissioners have done for Northampton County Schools:

- They have given us an increase in our Current Expense Allocation in the amount of \$150,000.00 of which \$50,000.00 will be used for moving expenses.
- They have allocated an extra \$400,000.00 in Capital Outlay for this school year.

Therefore, we are on the move, we will use those funds wisely, and we hope that we will have a smooth moving operation. Our Superintendent and administrators have put that plan in place and a lot of our own employees are involved and excited about it.
